1. The DSSSB vide its Advertisement No. 02/21 with closing date 24/06/2021, notice to the advertisement no. 02/2021 dated 23/06/2021 and notice in respect of post code 44/21, advertisement no. 02/21 dated 12/10/2021 had advertised 278 vacancies (EWS-27, UR-114, OBC-75, SC-41, ST-21 including Ex-Servicemen-28, Meritorious Sportsperson-13 OH-06, HH-08, VH-07, Multiple Disability-02) for the post of Junior Secretariat Assistant in Municipal Corporation of Delhi under Post Code 44/21. Board Conducted Tier-I (G) written examination for recruitment in respect of this post on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 16th and 23rd April, 2022 (Total 11 days).

2. The normalized marks obtained by 64,705 candidates who have duly appeared in written examination (online mode in multiple shifts) held on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 16th and 23rd April, 2022 has been uploaded on Board's website. Candidate can view their marks by logging into their account in the OARS Module www.dsssbonline.nic.in

3. Based on the performance in Tier-I written examination (online mode), out of these 64,705 candidates, total 3004 (Three Thousand Four) candidates {EWS- 216, UR-912, OBC-600, SC-329, ST-168, SP-104, ExSM-224, (PwD=OH-48, VH-56, HH-55, AIDS/SLDMI-16 and PHOB/PHSC-276)} as detailed below, have been provisionally shortlisted to appear in Skill Test/Typing Test in the ratio of 1:8 subject to attaining minimum qualifying marks and correctness of the information furnished by the candidates in their online application forms. The shortlisted candidates shall be called for Skill Test/Typing Test separately.

*Note: - Short listing for typing test is purely provisional of these candidates and these candidates are to be distributed among OH/VH/HH/AIDS/SLDMI sub-category as per their merit of written examination and being qualified in skill test also, at later stage, after ascertaining their type of disability viz OH/VH/HH/AIDS/SLDMI/Multiple Disability, on the basis of their disability certificate uploaded by them in their respective e-dossier.

4. Only those candidates have been considered in OBC Category who has declared that they had obtained OBC (Delhi) caste certificate in their online Application.
5. Since documents have not been called from the candidates along with the application forms as such detailed scrutiny regarding eligibility has not been carried out, and therefore, mere inclusion of names in the list of candidates qualifying for appearing in Skill Test/Typing Test does not entitled them any right over the post.
6. Reserved Category candidates who have obtained marks above or equal to the last shortlisted UR Candidates have been shortlisted against UR vacancies and their final selection to the post shall be considered in UR category, subject to availability of vacancies, otherwise for selection in their respective category.
7. As per the Board Notice dated 26/04/2013 the minimum qualifying marks in one Tier written examinations for UR Category Candidate is 40%, for OBC Candidate is 35% for SC/ST/PH candidate is 30% and for EXSM category candidate is 5% relaxation in their respective categories subject to a minimum of 30%.
8. The qualified candidates for appearing in Skill Test/Typing Test have been called in the ratio of 1:8 of the advertised vacancies; however all the candidates who have score marks equal to the cut off marks in each category have been shortlisted.
9. The details of skill typing test shall be notified separately by the Board. The candidates are hereby advised to check the website of the Board regularly.
10. While every care has been taken in preparing the result, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions, if any detected at any stage.
