Applications are invited from eligible candidates, only through online mode upto **11.05.2023** for direct recruitment to the posts of **Assistant Jailer (Men) and Assistant Jailer (Women) in Prisons & Correctional Services Department included in the Tamil Nadu Jail Subordinate Service.**

Clarification if any required may be obtained over phone and email well ahead of the last date for submission of online application. Candidates should follow the instructions given in the online application also.

1. ONE TIME REGISTRATION:

It is mandatory for the applicants to register their basic particulars through one - time online registration system on payment of Rs. 150/- (Rupees One hundred and fifty only) towards registration fee and then they should apply online for this recruitment. The one-time registration will be valid for five years from the date of registration. Thereafter, the registration should be renewed by paying the prescribed fee. **One Time Registration will not be considered as an application for any post. For further details refer para 2 of the "Commission's Instructions to Applicants".**

3. DISTRIBUTION OF VACANCIES:-

- (i) *As per G.O (Ms) No.91, Human Resources Management (S) Department, dated 13.09.2021, the Maximum Age Limit prescribed for appointment by direct recruitment is enhanced by 2 years. **[i.e., From 30 to 32 years]**

Explanation:

No Maximum age limit shall mean that the applicants should not have completed 60 years of age either on the date of notification or at the time of selection/ appointment to the post.

- (ii) "Others" [i.e., Applicants not belonging to SCs, SC(A)s, STs, MBCs/DCs, BC(OBCM)s and BCMs] who have put in five years and more of service in the State/Central Government are not eligible even if they are within the age limit.

(B) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION: (as on 12.04.2023):-

Applicants should possess the following or its equivalent qualification on the date of this Notification.

A degree of any of the Universities recognized by the University Grants Commission.

Note:

- (i) **The educational qualification prescribed for these posts should have been obtained by passing the required qualification in the order of studies 10th + HSC or its equivalent + Bachelors Degree Course. [Section 25 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016]. The results of examination should have been declared on or before the date of Notification. [Section 20 (4) (iv) of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016]**
- (ii) Applicants claiming equivalence of qualification to the prescribed qualification should submit evidence for equivalence of qualification in the form of Government Order issued on or before the date of this notification and upload it along with the online application, failing which, their application **will be summarily rejected after due process**. The Government Orders regarding equivalence of qualification issued after the date of this notification will not be accepted. - (i) The total number of free chances availed, will be calculated on the basis of claims made in previous applications.
- (ii) The number of free chances availed by the applicant will be verified by the Commission at any stage of the selection process.
- (iii) In case an applicant who makes a false claim for exemption from payment of application fee by suppressing information regarding his previous application(s) his candidature shall be rejected after due process and he shall be debarred for a period of one year from appearing for examinations and selections conducted by the Commission.

- (iv) Applicants are directed to carefully choose the options 'Yes' or 'No' regarding availing the fee concession.
- (v) Applicants are advised in their own interest, to keep an account of the number of times fee concession has been availed, irrespective of the information displayed in the <Application History> of the applicant dashboard.
- (vi) An application (irrespective of the post applied for) claiming fee concession will operate to exclude one chance from the number of free chances allowed.
- (vii) Applicants who have availed the maximum number of free chances permitted / applicants who do not wish to avail of the fee concession / applicants who are not eligible for fee concession, shall choose the option 'No' against the query regarding fee concession. (C) MODE OF PAYMENT OF EXAMINATION FEE:

- Written Examination fee of Rs.100/- (Rupees One Hundred only), is payable by online through Net Banking / Credit card / Debit card on or before the date of submission of online application, by choosing the option in the online application.
- Applicants have to pay the service charges also as applicable.
- Applicants can avail exemption from paying examination fee as per eligibility criteria.
- **Offline mode of payment in the form of demand draft / postal order etc. will not be accepted and the applications of candidates with such modes of payment will be summarily rejected.**
- Those who have registered in the One-Time Registration system and paid the registration fee of Rs.150/- and received the registration ID need not pay the Registration fee i.e., Rs.150/- and it is enough to pay the examination fee alone.
- Applicants who have made One-Time Registration must pay the prescribed examination fee for this recruitment unless fee exemption is claimed (One-Time Registration is only to avail exemption for Registration fee for a period of 5 years from the date of registration and it will not be considered as prescribed examination fee for this recruitment).

(D) CONCESSIONS

- Answer sheets of Paper-I and Part B of Paper II of the candidates will not be evaluated, if the candidate does not secure minimum qualifying marks in Part-A of Paper-II.
- The questions in Paper I and Part-B of Paper-II will be set both in Tamil and English.
- The candidate should appear for all the papers in the written examination for his / her answers to be evaluated and in case the candidate absents himself / herself for any of the papers, the paper attended will not be evaluated.

- d) If answers of a candidate for one paper is declared deemed not fit for valuation, the answers of the candidate for the remaining paper will not be evaluated.

8. SELECTION PROCEDURE

Selection will be made in single stage. The selection will be made on the basis of the total marks obtained by the applicants at the written examination, subject to the rule of reservation of appointments. The applicant who has not appeared for any of the Papers in the written examination will not be considered for selection, even if he/she secures the minimum qualifying marks for selection

Note:

- (i) Applicant should choose any **two** district centres as their preference for writing the examination. Applicants shall be allotted a venue in one of these two district centres.
- (ii) Request for change of Examination centre will not be permitted (For further details refer [para 17 \(A\) \(ii\) of 'Instructions to Applicants'](#))
- (iii) The Commission reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of examination centres and to re-allot the applicants accordingly.
- (iv) Applicants should appear for the written examinations / certificate verification at their own expenses.

10. (A) EMPLOYMENT DETAILS:

Candidates who are in the service of the Indian Union or a State in India or in the employment of Local Bodies or Universities or Quasi Government Organisations or Public Sector Units constituted under the authority of the Government of India or of a State in India, whether in regular service or in temporary service must inform the Commission of such fact, at the time of applying.

Suppression of the fact of employment by candidates shall result in rejection of candidature after due process. Candidates should produce No Objection Certificate when called for. [For further details refer para. 14 (P) of "Instructions to Applicants"]

(B) DECLARATION REGARDING CRIMINAL CASES(OR) DISCIPLINARY CASES:

- (i) Candidates who have declared pending criminal or disciplinary cases in their online application, must upload the copy of First Information Report (FIR) or memorandum of charges / show cause notice, as the case may be. Failure to **upload such papers along with online application**, shall result in rejection of candidature after due process.
- (ii) Candidates who have declared conviction in criminal cases or punishment in disciplinary cases, in their online application, must upload the relevant court orders and/or release orders or memorandum of proceedings, as the case may be, when called for. Failure to upload such papers, shall result in rejection of candidature after due process.
- (iii) In case of any criminal case is filed / disciplinary action is taken against or conviction / punishment is imposed on a candidate after submission of the on-line application at any stage of the recruitment process before the completion of entire selection process such candidates should report this fact to the Commission in the next immediate stage when Commission calls for uploading/ producing documents. Failure to comply with these instructions shall result in rejection of candidature after due process and debarment for a period of one year. [Para.14 (S) of "Instructions to Applicants"].

Any violation of instructions therein will result in rejection of application and forfeiture of his/her candidature after due process.

11. GENERAL INFORMATION:

(A) The rule of reservation of appointments is applicable to this recruitment.

Not exceeding 10% vacancies of direct recruitment quota shall be filled up from the categories of Warders Grade-I and Warders Grade-II of the Tamil Nadu Jail Subordinate Service, who are graduates and have put in five years of service in their respective categories. **Women are not eligible for the post of Assistant Jailor (Men) and Men are not eligible for the post of Assistant Jailor (Women).**

(B) Persons Studied in Tamil Medium:

- (i) As per Section 2(d) of the Tamil Nadu Appointment on preferential basis in the services under the State of Persons Studied in Tamil Medium Act, 2010, as amended by Act 35 of 2020, **Persons Studied in Tamil Medium means a person who has studied through Tamil Medium of instruction upto the educational qualification prescribed for direct recruitment in the rules or regulations or orders applicable to any appointment in the services under the State.**
- (ii) Candidates claiming to be Persons Studied in Tamil Medium (PSTM) must upload evidence for the same in the form of SSLC/HSC Transfer Certificate, Provisional Certificate, Convocation Certificate, Degree Certificate, Mark Sheets, Certificate from the Board or University or from the Institution, as the case may be, with a recording that he/she had studied **the entire duration of the respective course(s) through Tamil Medium of instruction at the time of submission of online application.**

- (iii) Candidates must upload documents as evidence of having studied in the Tamil Medium, all educational qualification upto the educational qualification prescribed **at the time of submission of online application.**

Example:

If the prescribed educational qualification is Degree, then the candidate should have studied from the First Standard to SSLC, Higher Secondary Course or its equivalent and Under Graduate Degree Course through Tamil medium of instruction. (For further details refer to para. 4-E of the "Instructions to Applicants")

- (iv) If no such document as evidence for 'PSTM' is available, a certificate from the Principal/Head Master / District Educational Officer / Chief Educational Officer / District Adi-Dravidar Welfare Officer/ Controller of Examinations / Head / Director of Educational Institution / Director / Joint Director of Technical Education / Registrar of Universities, as the case may be, in the prescribed format must be uploaded at the time of submission of online application, for each and every educational qualification up to the educational qualification prescribed.
- (v) Failure to upload such documents at the time of submission of online application as evidence for 'Persons Studied in Tamil Medium' for all educational qualification up to the educational qualification prescribed, shall result in the rejection of candidature after due process.
- (vi) Documents uploaded at the time of submission of online applications as proof of having studied in Tamil medium, for the partial duration of any course / private appearance at any examination, shall not be accepted and shall result in the rejection of candidature after due process. (For further details refer to para. 14 (R) and 2 (W) of the "Instructions to Applicants")

- (C) The selection for appointment to the posts is purely provisional subject to the final orders in the Writ Petitions, if any, pending on the files of the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras and Madurai Bench of Madras High Court.

- (D) i. As per Sections 26 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, reservation of appointment to **"Destitute Widow" will not applicable to this recruitment.**
- ii. As per Section 27(c) of Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, 5% of vacancies shall be set apart for Ex-Servicemen in the posts which are classified under Group-'C' (i.e.) between Level-2 (Rs.15900-58500) and Level-12 (Rs.35600-130800) in the pay matrix. If no qualified and suitable Ex-Servicemen belonging to a particular category is available for selection for appointment against reserved turn, such turn shall be filled up by a candidate other than Ex-Servicemen belonging to the particular communal category.

(E) **PERSONS WITH BENCHMARK DISABILITY :**

As per G.O. (Ms.) No. 81, Home (Prison-II) Department, dated 24.02.2023, the said posts have been exempted and identified as not suitable for differently abled persons. (**Annexure-III**)

- (F) Wherever vacancies are reserved for Arunthathiyars on preferential basis, even after filling the vacancies reserved for SC (Arunthathiyars) on preferential basis, if more number of qualified Arunthathiyars are available, they shall be entitled to compete with the Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars in the inter-se-merit among them and if any posts reserved for Arunthathiyars remain unfilled for want of adequate

number of qualified applicants, it shall be filled by Scheduled Castes other than Arunthathiyars.

[Section 27 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016].

- (G) Evidence for all the claims made in the online application should be uploaded / submitted in time when documents are called for. Any subsequent claim made after submission of online application will not be entertained. Failure to upload the documents at the time of submission of online application will entail rejection of application after due process.
- (H) Suppression of following material information in the online application regarding (i) free chances availed (ii) Employment in the Service of the Indian Union or a State in India or in the employment of Local Bodies or University or Quasi Government Organization or Public Sector units constituted under the authority of the Government of India or of a State in India in regular service or temporary service (iii) Wilful suppression of criminal cases / disciplinary action pending / punishments if any, against the applicant (iv) violation of undertaking given by the applicant in the online application etc., may invite suitable penal action including debarment for a specific period as decided by the Commission for various recruitments/ selections conducted by the Commission, besides rejection of application after due process.
- (I) Correct and true information regarding arrest, convictions, criminal or any disciplinary proceedings initiated / pending or finalised, debarment / disqualification by any recruiting agency, if any, should also be furnished to the Commission at the time of application. Prisons and Correctional Services Department – Direct Recruitment – 4% reservation to the Differently Abled person followed in Government appointments – Exemption to the executive posts in Prison and Correctional Services Department - Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for exempting the Prison Department from implementing 3% reservation to the Differently Abled persons for the executive posts of Prison Department.

2. In the Government Order second read above, among other things the Government have issued the following orders under the proviso to section 34(1) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (Central Act 49 of 2016) regarding exempt any establishment from the 4% reservation:-

- i) the reservation of 4% vacancies earmarked for the differently abled persons will be applicable to

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all the posts in respect of 'C' and 'D' categories in employment.

- ii) the reservation of 4% vacancies for differently abled persons need not be made applicable in the case of recruitment by transfer/promotion as it would amount to giving double preference to these candidates.
- iii) If any department/establishment is of the view that any particular post in 'C' and 'D' category is not suitable for differently abled persons, in such case, it may in consultation with the State Commissioner for the Differently Abled and the Government shall issue appropriate orders.

3. In the letter third & fifth read above, the Director General of Police/Director General of Prisons and Correctional Services has stated that the 'B' and 'C' Group employees working in Prison Department consists of executive personnel from Deputy Inspector General of Prisons down to Grade II Warder. The entry-level category in the executive side of Prison Department i.e. Grade II Warder is filled up by common recruitment through the Tamil Nadu Uniformed Services Recruitment Board. Further, the post of Assistant Jailor and Jailor are being filled up through Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. As in other uniformed services i.e., Police Department and Fire & Rescue Services Department, the working conditions for the executive personnel in Prison Department are entirely different. The duties and responsibilities of the Executive Staff in Prison Department (as stipulated in Rules of Tamil Nadu Prison Rules, 1983) reveals the arduous task requisite from them. Prison executive staff are working inside Prison where various kinds of prisoners such as terrorists, fundamentalists, murderers, hard-core criminals are incarcerated. Prison personnel are tackling these prisoners daily as a routine. They are responsible for the security of the prisoners. They are also the supervisory body of the prisoners and hence they are expected to be in good physical shape.

4. The Director General of Police/Director General of Prisons and Correctional Services has also stated that, the Executive posts in Prison and Correctional Services Department are meant for maintaining strict control over prisoners, prevent escapes etc. Being a disciplined force the executive subordinate have to practice drill, musketry etc., differently abled persons cannot also respond to urgent and emergent calls of duty like riots, escapes etc. Hence, the reservation of 4%

vacancies for the differently abled persons are not suitable for the executive posts in 'C' and 'D' categories in Prison and Correctional Services Department.

5. The Director General of Police/Director General of Prisons and Correctional Services has therefore requested the Government to exempt the executive posts of Prisons and Correctional Services Department from the implementing 4% reservation applicable to the differently abled persons.

6. In the letter fourth read above, the Commissioner for Welfare of the Differently Abled has also stated that in the above provision, it is clear that there is scope for exemption for any Government establishment from the provisions of Section 34 of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and further stated that the nature of work of the incumbent executive posts in Prison Department are distinct in nature which has been clearly stipulated in Tamil Nadu Prison Rules, 1983. Further, he has informed that while implementing 3% reservation as per the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995, the Prison Department has already obtained orders from the Government for such exemption for these two posts. Similarly, it is applicable for 4% reservation also. He has therefore stated that in view of the foregoing circumstances and nature of work in respect of executive posts in Prison Department, the Government may exempt the Prison Department from implementing 4% reservation for the executive posts from Deputy Inspector General of Prisons down to grade II Warder of Prison Department as per Section 34 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

7. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Director General of Police/Director General of Prisons and Correctional Services, after considering the remarks of the Commissioner for Welfare of Differently Abled. Accordingly, the following Notification shall be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the second proviso to sub-section (1) of section 34 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (Central Act 49 of 2016), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, in consultation with the State Commissioner for Welfare of the Differently Abled, having regard to the nature of work carried out in the executive posts of the Prisons and Correctional Services Department, hereby exempts the Prisons and Correctional Services Department in the State of Tamil Nadu from the provisions of the said section 34 in respect of

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reservation of appointment of differently abled persons to the executive posts of the said Prisons and Correctional Services Department.
